This festival is now celebrated all across the world by the people who have their roots in India. With the Ganesh festival just around the corner, United Way Mumbai has prepared this Greensha Advisory to share some ideas to make the celebration eco-friendly this year.



GO FOR CLAY/TREE GANESHA IDOLS

Let's opt for the eco-friendly idols instead of buying idols made of Plaster of Paris (PoP). Eco-friendly idols made from natural colours, fertilisers, and red soil are 100% biodegradable and easily immerses in the bucket at home.





LIMIT TO SMALL GANESHA IDOLS

The huge size and design of the idols often catches the eye of the beholder. Most often these huge idols are made of PoP. For households, it is better to choose simple and small idols that can be easily immersed in a tub of water at home. The big pandals, can opt for a metal/stone idol that can be used every year.



GO FOR ECO FRIENDLY DECORATION

Flowers, tree leaves, colored paper, rangolis, and diyas are excellent alternative and traditional choice for decorations made of plastic to celebrate ecofriendly festival.



ENERGY EFFICIENT CELEBRATION

While lighting up the community pandals use energyefficient lighting fixtures like LED lights or traditional earthen divas. Make sure that excessive lights are not used to avoid wastage of electricity.



MAKE COMPOST FROM NIRMALYA

You can make a home compost of all the biodegradable items such as flowers and garlands to fertilize your other house plants.



MAKE USE OF ARTIFICIAL PONDS OR OPT FOR SYMBOLIC IMMERSION

Consider immersing idols in artificially made tanks by MCGM instead of immersing them in the natural water bodies such as ponds, creeks & sea.

You can also symbolically immerse your idol in a bucket or pick a metal or stone idol to be immersed at home and use it again the following year.

USE BIODEGRADABLE PLATES AND CUPS

Several biodegradable plates and cups are available in the market which are made from Areca/Palm leaf, Sugarcane Bagasse, Bamboo and Corn Starch.



3 R`S - REDUCE, REUSE, RECYCLE

Reduce your consumption by opting for reusable products and recycling your waste. Spread the awareness among your neighbours, friends and family for Green celebration.



KEEP AN EYE OUT FOR THE NEWLY ADOPTED SINGLE-USE PLASTIC BAN.

List of banned single-use plastic items:

- 1. Thermocol decorations
- 2. Plastic cutlery (spoons, forks, knives)
- 3. Plastic utensils (plates and cups)
- 4. Plastic-wrapped products



GO FOR POLLUTION FREE CELEBRATION

Use traditional instruments in place of loudspeakers and avoid playing loud music to reduce Noise pollution. Do not use firecrackers to mitigate Air, Noise and Soil pollution.



SAFETY GUIDELINES

Follow all safety protocols including use of masks, hand sanitizer and follow social standards in public places during aarti, darshan and visarjan. Virtual aartis or darshans can be offered to relatives and friends.




