Emergency post-crash care response is a critical area of intervention in reducing the number of road traffic crash deaths in our country. It is commendable to note that, your organization has taken up the cause of creation of a force of trained first responders who can be the Good Samaritans in times of need.

Till date a total of 209 traffic police personnel & 500 commercial vehicle drivers have been trained by you with first responder skills through an interactive training module using demonstration & hands-on exercises of various techniques of bystander care with the help of expert resource persons. The participants have been educated about the basic DO's and DON'Ts of bystander care, Good Samaritans law and the protocol for mobilizing 108 ambulance service of Govt. of Maharashtra. I am glad to admit that, a few success stories have already been reported to my office wherein some of the trained police officers have responded to the road traffic crash and helped the victims based on the training received and by using the contents of the first responder kits given.
